1 Brief on the Results of the Symposium

Presentations and an Environmental Study on the Recycling Society

14 groups (2 from Japan, 2 from Korea, 7 from China, 2 from Russia, and 1 from Mongol) made presentations on their own activities such as segregation of garbage or recycling, and then, exchanged opinions. They also had lectures on environment.

Cooperative Field Activity for Environmental Conservation

All participants made compost at a park near the symposium venue in Shenyang City. Also, a leaflet on the recycling society was handed out to each participant. They confirmed to expand the environmental activities after the symposium.

Adoption of the Symposium Declaration

The symposium declaration was adopted to call for the affirmative participation of all youths in the Northeast Asia in environmental conservation activities that are necessary for the coexistence with the nature and a recycling-oriented society.
