The International Environmental Symposium of Northeast Asian Region

1. Objective of the Symposium

The aim of the International Environmental Symposium of Northeast Asian Region is to exchange know-how, information and technologies concerning environmental protection measures and international environmental cooperation, and promote a comprehensive cooperation for the protection of the environment among local governments of the Region.

The symposium was held in Jiangsu Province, China in 2001, in Chungcheongnam Province, Korea in 2002 and in Khabarovsk Territory, Russia in 2003 respectively. Main participants were administrative officials from local governments in Northeast Asian Region.
