

Individual Projects of the Environment Subcommittee

The North East Asia Regional Environmental Program for the Youth Training through the Experience 2008

1 Objectives:

This program is conducted by municipalities, an economic society and an academic society collaboratively, with the objectives to give young people an opportunity to have direct experience, such as an environmental volunteer activity, to raise the awareness for the environmental problem and international cooperation to protect it. Finally, it is expected to develop young people to think and act by themselves.

2 Outline:

(1) Date: August 21 (Thu) & 22 (Fri), 2008

(2) Place: Taean County, Chungchongnam-do, Korea

(3) Contents:

- Theme: Natural environmental preservation
- Practical Experience: 96 young people from 8 municipalities in 4 countries conducted a joint activity for the environmental preservation. They cleaned up the oil slick which was caused by the accident of the crude oil tanker in December 2007.
- Supports by various societies: Various societies supported this program collaboratively. The academic society dispatched experts to make a lecture beforehand, and send student supporters. The economic society also sent the expert to instruct and help participants.
- Presentation: Participating municipalities made presentations on their own activities.
